### **General Safety**




Not a Substitute for Proper Adult Supervision: You MUST check your children's activities regularly.

Not Intended for Use as a Medical Camera: This appliance should not replace adult supervision.

Not a Toy: Do not allow children to play with this appliance.

Risk of Suffocation: Keep all packaging materials out of reach of children.

### **Location Safety**



#### Strangulation Hazard:

Children can be entangled in cords. Keep the appliance, adapter and power cords out of the reach of children at all times, at least 3 feet /1 meter away.

#### Danger from Power Cords:

To avoid possible danger from power cords, the cords should be secured and never be hung on or near the crib or playpen. Do not place in the crib, bed or playpen.

#### Keep Away From Heat:

Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers and stoves.








## **Product Diagram**

## USING YOUR BABY MONITOR



### **Getting Started**

### 1. Plugging in the Camera

Connect the camera to a 5V DC power supply using the included AC adapter. The camera will power on automatically. After approximately 15 seconds, the power-up process will be complete.





Place the camera and power cord out of reach of children. Camera is not battery powered. Keep plugged in when in use.

### 2. Charging the Monitor

It takes around 6 hours to fully charge. The charging indicator will turn on while charging and off when fully charged.



#### 3. Pairing the Camera with the Monitor

By default, the camera has been paired with the monitor when manufactured. If the camera is disconnected, please refer to page 13.



Keep camera ard monitor within a distance of 12-40 in (30-100cm)when pairing. Note that microphone feedback might occur when they are close to each other.

### 4. Positioning the Camera

Keep the camera 3-16 ft (1-5m)away from your baby's crib, playpen and baby bed for best viewing and safety reasons.

### 5. Wall Mounting the Camera (Optional)


Select a spot to mount the camera, ideally 5-8 ft high, keeping it beyond the reach of children. Install the included screw into the wall and mount the camera onto the screw.



Do not release the camera until you're sure it is firmly mounted.


## Function & Operations

### 1. Interface Overview













You can then use the arrow keys to adjust the volume and brightness.

If you have paired two cameras, press / let to select the corresponding camera. When your selection box is on the left, you are controlling the left camera, and the Talk Volume, Lullaby, etc., will affect the left camera.




When your green selection box is on the right, you are controlling the right camera, and the Talk Volume, Lullaby, etc., will affect the right camera.




## 3. Lullaby

Press , select through 1, and press / to select lullables . Press to choose random play, loop play, or turn off.

### 5. Screen Timeout

Press  $\equiv$ , select through  $\longrightarrow$   $\longrightarrow$  screen Timeout, and press  $\bigcirc$  /  $\bigcirc$  to select duration  $\longrightarrow$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$  to set the desired time for the screen to turn off automatically.




### 6. Add a Camera

Press  $\equiv$  , select through  $\bigcirc$   $\rightarrow$   $\bigcirc$  Add , press the Pair button on the camera

near the antenna and listen for the prompt tone, then the camera will pair with the monitor automatically.






### 7. Splict View and Auto Switch View

Press (=), select through ( ) cam View , and select ( ) to view two cameras in split-screen mode.

In split-screen mode, the audio will switch between cameras every 15 seconds.



Press , select through and select to view two cameras in split-screen mode. Once set, the screen and audio will switch between connected cameras every 15 seconds.




### 8. Delete a Camera

, select through TID Delete and select the camera number 1/2 to view.

· At least one camera should stay connected.

The current camera number will appear at the top of the screen.

If you want to remove the remaining camera, press the PAIR button three times to disconnect it, and then you can delete the remaining camera.

### 9. VOX (Voice Activated Alert)

1) Press  $\stackrel{\frown}{=}$  , select through  $\stackrel{\frown}{=}$   $\rightarrow$   $\stackrel{\frown}{=}$  vox .

2) choose a sensitivity level. The higher the VOX sensitivity level, the more sensitive the camera is in detecting sounds for transmitting to the monitor.

In VOX mode, the screen will stop broadcasting sounds from the camera side untile the audio detected is above the alert level.



### 10. Nursing Reminder

Press, select through Alarm Clock to select the group, you can set up to four alarms to set a specific time for the monitor to alert you for nursing.

The reminder will sound for 30 seconds and again after 1 minute if no action is taken, but will shut off automatically if none is taken after three times.



### 11. Safe Protection

Press the button, then select Camera Wi-Fi On to allow the camera to access the app.

Select Camera Wi-Fi Off to disconnect the camera's signal from the app.



Note: App can only access camera when wifi is ON.

## 12. Privacy Mode

Press the (=), then select Privacy ON to set the camera to sleep mode, stopping video and audio transmission. Select Privacy OFF to resume normal camera operation.



### 13. Detection

1) Crying Detection

select through → 🌋 Crying Detection to turn on/off detection. Monitor will alert you when detect the baby's cry.





For example, select high sensitivity while your baby is sleeping to receive alerts for any movement. For an awake and playing baby, choose medium or low sensitivity. Note: Movements such as door swings or curtains blown by the wind, which cause changes in the camera's view, may also trigger motion detection.





· Press (= select through Action Tracking to turn ON/OFF camera tracking.

The camera continuously tracks your baby, ensuring they remain in your sight. Note: When Action Tracking is enabled, the camera will rotate to follow facial movements—this is normal behavior and there is no need to worry.




### 14. Talkback

(a) to talk and release to listen.

- You can press (1/2) (0k) to select one camera to talk to.


  When the video volume is set level. · In split-screen mode: the talkback function is activated on the left camera by default.
  - · When the video volume is set low, you might not be able to hear from the camera side.
  - · When (a) is pressed, the sound from the camera side will not be heard.

### 15. Screen Off Mode

Press briefly to enter Screen Off Mode. In this mode, the monitor will continue to receive sounds from the camera. Press any button to wake up.



### 16. Zoom In & Zoom Out

When viewing a camera, press (1) to magnify the screen at 2x or 4x.



### 17. Pan & Tilt

Press / / v to select the camera, and press ok to enter camera control, press / / / v to view from different angles, 135 degrees vertically and 300 degrees horizontally.




## 18. Night Vision

The nignt vision is automatically activated in a dim environment.

Infrared LEDs attached on the front of the camera allow you to see the baby in a dark room.




